"PROPELLER SHAFT TUNNEL SILENCER

For a better term I will call it the "silencer" or "rattle silencer", or maybe even an "oil catcher" or "seal". Regardless of what name we want to hang on the piece, there is a strip of felt on the inside of the front of the propeller shaft tunnel.

This piece of felt is $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16" long and is held in position by five small round-headed "cotter pins", the same style that are used to hold the rubber silencers on the chassis rails.

In examination of the remains of the piece I took off of my car, I found it to be about the same thickness as the material sold by Moss Motors and Abingdon Spares for black tool box liner material. (%" thick).
