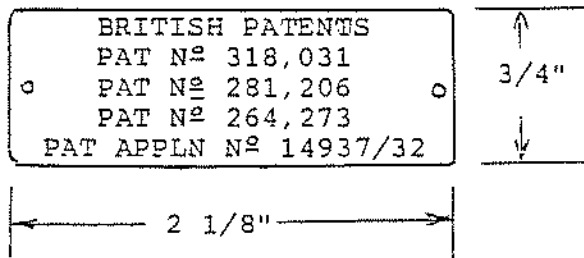
BRASS IDENTIFICATION PLATES

A Question has been asked as to a brass "instructional plate" back by the battery? I know of no such plate although it might be, the INSTRUCTION MANUAL that was issued with the J2 shows on the inside of the cover page and on page two, the identification and instruction plates of the car. They are as follows:

- Identification Plate --- see tech article number 54.
- The engine Plate -- mounted on right side of valve cover.
- Choke and slow running control instructions -- found on plate on shift extension arm.
- Lubrication instructions -- found on both bulk head supports
- Foot brake adjustment -- Located on floorboard (under carpet) on drivers side.

Other "instruction plates" not shown in instructional manual known to have existed are ----

- Patents Plate -- Located on left side, center of valve cover



- CARBODIES PLATE -- located behind driver's seat - see tech article number 113
