So this article is for what ever value you can get from it.

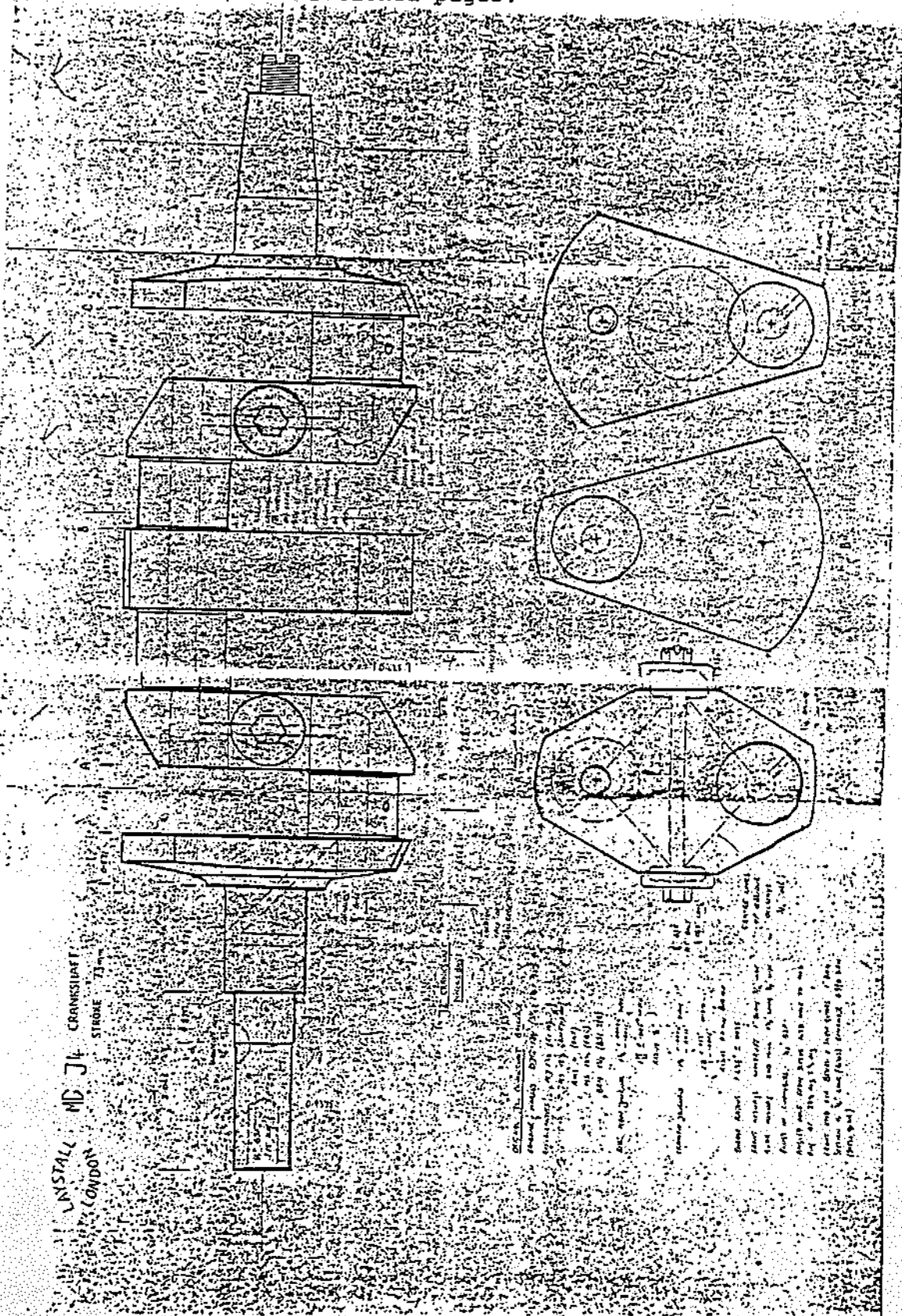
The following pages were required to try to get the 15" x 27" drawing to you on 8½ x 11 paper. My problem is that black lines on blue paper do not reproduce very well.
