GEARBOX NUMBERING

This may help you understand some of the numbers on your gearbox.

Note the reference to MMM Register P9 refers information similar to what I show in tech article number 184.

Recent correspondence between Tony Jenkins and Mike Hawke has brought about a ray of light on the mystery of the numbers stamped on Wolsely type gear boxes as fitted to J,L,P,N,KN and some K types. The two numbers stamped in front of the remote control are the serial number and the engine code, thus

1228 = Serial Number
135 = Engine Code Single-breather PA
(See MMM Register, P9)

The numbers stamped behind the remote control is the ratio of the speedometer drive fitted\

$\frac{8}{14}$ denotes a J2 ratio

Also, an addendum to page 9 of your Register, the engine code for J3 s would appear to be 117.
