North Shropshire Scatter Rally– Saturday 25th August 2018

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Humber Register, on behalf of the Inter-Register Club will organise a Scatter Rally taking place in North Shropshire on Saturday 25th August 2018, starting and finishing at the Millennium Hall, Cockshutt, SY12 0JQ.
Map Reference: OS126: 433 293 (On the A528 Shrewsbury to Ellesmere road).

2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations and any instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event. The event will run under an MSA Certificate of Exemption Permit.

Permit Number 108121.

3. The event is open to pre-1941 cars entered by fully elected members of clubs comprising the Inter Register Club as listed below. **The event is also open to current members of the VSCC.**

All Entrants must produce a valid Club Membership card at signing on.

4. The event is a round of the 2018 Inter-Register Championship.
5. The programme of the event will be:
 - Scrutineering and Signing on from 10.15 am. at the Millenium Hall, where refreshments will be available from 10.00. Any car not signed on by 11.00 may be penalised or refused a start.
 - Route cards will be issued from 11.00 am. Cars will leave in their own time.
 - Late lunch will be available at around 15.30 back at the finish – see Paragraph 18, below.
6. Competitors will cover around 65-70 miles depending on their chosen route. The OS Landranger map required for the event is OS126 (Edition April 2013 used by your organiser; any **RECENT** edition - 2010 or younger - should suffice). Apart from a Romer, ruler, pencils and eraser no instruments are required. Navigation will be by various common methods and should be readily achievable and unambiguous. Novice and beginner navigators (see Para. 9 below) will be provided with additional assistance if required.
7. All entrants' cars must be road legal, i.e. 'taxed' for the road, and, as a minimum, RTA insurance. All drivers must hold a current Driving Licence for the car entered.
8. The event will consist of two classes: Experts and Novices. A novice crew is one where no member has won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd class award, or has been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd, in any VSCC or IRC navigational event in the previous three years. (If anyone wishes to 'tour' and not compete, please bring the map and it will be marked for you on the day.) Absolute beginners (ie first event) will be welcome to extra assistance. A team comprises the three highest placed cars of a single marque.

9. **The Entry List opens on the publication of these Regulations and closes on Wednesday 22nd August 2018.** Entries *may* be accepted on the day (cash payment only), but please telephone or e-mail your intention to attend on or before Wednesday 22nd August, especially if food is required. **No notification, no food.**

10. Entry Fees will be £20.00 per vehicle, to include bacon roll and tea or coffee before the event.

All entries must be made on the official entry form accompanied by the appropriate fee. Cheques should be made payable to "Nigel Coulter" (no post-dated cheques, please) and sent to the Secretary of the Meeting:

A full refund will be given if entries are withdrawn and notification is given in writing or e-mail by the closing date, but not once the event has taken place.

11. The maximum entry for this meeting, including reserves, is 30. The minimum is 8. Should this latter number not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt; however should the event be oversubscribed, priority will be given to Inter-Register Championship contenders.

12. The officials will be: Clerk of the Course: Nigel Coulter Scrutineer: Jim Wood

13. Any ties will be resolved in order of the number of adult crew, horsepower (RAC Rating) of the engine then the age of the car concerned.

14. Marking: There will be 21 locations to plot, and on visiting them a question must be answered, on the Score Card provided, as proof of visit. The locations will vary in score, ranging from 3 points to 15 points depending on the difficulty of plotting and /or getting there and/or funding the answer once there. You should aim to visit a MAXIMUM of 14 locations. If more than 14 answers are submitted only the 14 LOWEST scores will be counted. There will be a target finish time and penalty points will be awarded at the rate of one point per minute late after this time. Maximum lateness is 30 minutes. **Arrival after this limit may result in disqualification.**

15. Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with the MSA Regulations – Section C5

16. Awards: There will be:

- Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each class (subject to minimum of 10 in class); and a team prize. Special awards may be made at the discretion of the organisers.
- The Trowbridge Bowl for the first overall, and the Trowbridge Novice Award for the best Novice.
- Inter Register points will be awarded for individual places overall, and for team places, where a team comprises up to the highest scoring three cars of an Inter-Register Club.

17. As part of the entry fee, tea or coffee and bacon rolls will be available prior to the start at the Millennium Hall, Cockshutt. High tea will then be available at the finish comprising cottage pie and peas at a cost of £4.00 per head. Please advise on the Entry Form if you have any specific dietary requirements.

18. Petrol is available from Ellesmere about 4 miles NNW of the start OS126: 402 349. **Although you might pass a garage, there is no specific fuel availability en route, so please ensure that you have an adequate supply before signing on.**

19. If anyone requires accommodation locally, there are B&Bs in the area and Oswestry has hotels including a Travelodge and Premier Inn (www.oswestry-welshborders.org.uk is a good place to start.). Please contact Nigel Coulter (details in Paragraph 10, above) if help is required with this.
