Traditionally starting from the steam railway centre at Toddington, and following an interesting 65 mile route through the Cotswolds and surrounding countryside, using little used byways, this years late summer event visits the interesting and lovely private property of Rodmarton Manor near Cirencester.



Built in 1909 for the Biddulph family who still reside here today, Rodmarton Manor is the supreme example of a house built and all its furniture made according to the Arts and Crafts ideals. It was one of the last country houses to be built and

furnished in the traditional way, when everything was done by hand using local stone, and timber. Although open to the public at certain times throughout the summer, we have an exclusive day to ourselves for discovering the delights this magnificent property has to offer.

With beautiful walks throughout the 8 acre Cotswold grounds and gardens, excellent cafeteria, plus special parking arrangements, participants can expect this years event as always to be pretty special.

Entry fee: £17.50 (Includes free entry into Rodmarton Manor gardens and grounds for two, route instructions, and finishers plaque).
Additional £3.00 extra each for guided tour of house, payable directly to Rodmarton personnel during visit.
