PAINT, CHROME, AND BRASS OF THE J2

Headlamp shells - painted body color Headlamp shell rims - Chrome plated Logo on headlight shells - Chrome plated Running light shells - Painted Body color Running light shell rims - Chrome plated Running light Logo - chrome plated Hinge on bonnet - Originally polished stainless steel Four round-headed bolts in bonnet top - chrome plated - not painted Headlamp and front wing support for cycle fender J2 - painted body color Cross bar on front wing support - painted body color Front wing lower stays (cycle fenders) painted body color Rear wing rear stays (cycle fenders) painted body color Cycle fenders wing fixing bolts - chrome plated Door hinges - chrome plated Radiator screen - painted silver engine color - (see note below as color varies) sump - unpainted gear box - unpainted gear box control arm - unpainted brake drums - Shounk on edge was polished, center was body color. all chasis including axles and brake plates - painted black inside of fenders - painted body color Hood frame and bows - painted black Inside of bonnet - painted body color Firewall and bulkhead - galvanized metal, unpainted Seat runners - No seat runner on original J2's , Seat back support - Rods entering holes in floor board. Rims and spokes - match the leather upholstery, except with tudor Brown upholstery, when the wheels are cream. Knock-offs - chrome plated

engine color note: all two seater - red all four seaters - green all racing cars - blue

bell housing only of gear box was also per engine col
