THE RADIATOR

The method of construction of the J2 reatiator and materials used were exectly the same as in the later TC series. Even the pattern of the flutes on the top header tank are the same.

The key difference is the fins attached to the flutes for cooling. While the TC has horizontal fins, the J2 has "Honeycomb" or Hexagon fins.

If you have an old radiator from your J2 and if it needs a new core, a local radiator shop should be able to take a TC radiator and your old J2 radiator and re-build you a good radiator.
