REAR LICENCE PLATE AND TAIL LIGHT PLATE

Although most of the Rear license plates and tail light holders have been modified over the years, the original was a $4" \times 20"$ plate with a small ear on the lower right side.

Modification of the plate to other shapes has taken place because the original "pencil tail light" was only a tail light. There was no brake lights. In addition, English law required that able cars on the road, regardless or year manufactured have turn signals and so cars being imported to the U.S.A. since shortly after the early 50's have been modified.
