## RADIATOR SUPPORT RODS

The radiator support rods on the J-series are used just as they are on the later T-series cars. There is a bracket on each outside of the radiator resevour tank. A second bracket is located at the top hole on the bulk head support braket. The radiator support rod has a yoke on each end with threads so the the length on the rod can be adjusted. There is a lock nut on the rod to secure the yoke from turning. The two yokes are secured to the mounting brackets by bolts.

All parts of the radiator support rod are painted black.

The adjustment of the radiator support rods are done so that the bonnet fit on the radiator is correct. Do not forget that the radiator support under the radiator has slots so the bottom of the radiator can be moved forward or back and can assist in getting correct total radiator/bonnet fit.
