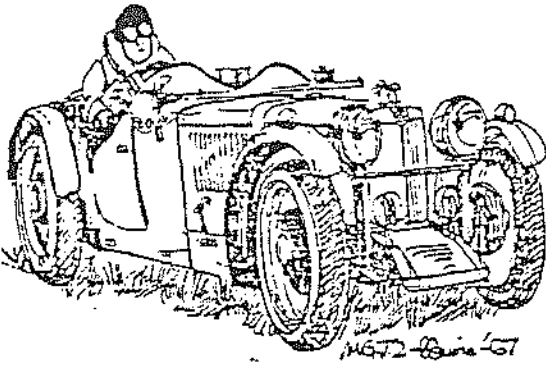

### O.S AND N.S.

I have been properly and nicely corrected. My non-expert status was obvious as several J2 owners let me know of an error in technical article number 161.

O.S. does not mean "old stock" and N.S. does not mean "new stock".

As most all J2 owners know and some of us forget from time to time that O.S. is for "Off Side" and N.S. is for "Near Side".

Off side (O.S.) is the right side

Near side (N.S.) is the left side
