



RUNNING LIGHT POSITION

Question George: Are the running lights centered on top of the cycle fender (center rib) or are they set off to the outside?


Answer: Even though I have seen several pictures of restored cars where the running lights on the cycle fenders have been positioned to the outside of the center rib-----



--- If you will look at any early photographs of the J2 find the running light setting right on top center.

One parts supplier in England said that the original factory mounted running lights had a base that was thick and with a indentation that would accept the rib.

This same parts supplier suggested that if you do not have an original, thick based running light, that you use the thick type sidelight base rubbers, cut away some of the center material, and get the center position.



Either thick based unit or use of thick rubber (center cut-away to alow a center mount).
