WINDSCREEN WIPERS

I was asked to describe the windscreen wipers and drive system on the J2. The best discription is as follows:

- a) for the later models with electric wiper motor, the system is like that of the later M.G. TC. The electric motor drive shaft protrudes through the frame and the wiper blade arm tightens onto the shaft like that of the T series units.
- b) for the early models with the suction wiper motor, the motor drive shaft protruded out the front of the windscreen frame. An arm fastened to the shaft and extended downwards to the cross rod below. This is similar to the later center mounted, electric wiper motor on the TD series.

On both systems, the wiper arms are of the same design as those on the later T series with a cross rod mounted in similar style. The wiper arm post is similar to the sketches below.
