If your steering wheel needs to be re-worked here are some companies that claim to do this kind of work. I do not know anything about any of them so proceed on your own!

STEERING wheel restoration: full time since 1976, much of my work is recommendations from others, which speaks for itself, minor crack repairs in epoxy, start at \$130 to completion, complete rin circle remolding in bard rubber using my exclusive self-developed irransplant system for about 2/3 the cost of plastic injection molding the others do. All work finished in color, spin-dried painting, oven cured, rim remolding covering most sizes with smooth conventional designs, including banjo stainless, chrome or rod type spokes with solid steel hub centers, including marine, commercial, cost rangesto completion; 16°, 5225; 17°, 5240; 18°, 5250; 20°, \$350; add \$12 handling, shipping, can return COD, please send SASE for information.
