SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Pre War Austin Seven Club, on behalf of the Inter-Register Club will organise a Scatter Rally taking place in Herefordshire on Saturday 16th September, starting and finishing at Shobdon Airfield., map ref OS sheet 148 399619. The entire event will take place using sheet 148, to the East of the Welsh/English border and to the North of the River Wye
2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations and any instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event. The event will run under an MSA Certificate of Exemption Permit.

3. The event is open to three overall classes of entrants. To take part in the 2023 Inter Register Trophy cars entered by fully elected members of clubs comprising the Inter Register Club as listed below.

To participate in the Scatter rally, pre-war cars or those built before 1963 are most welcome. Entrants must be members of an Inter Register Club, or an invited MSUK club.

All Entrants must produce a valid Club Membership card at signing on. All drivers, navigators and passengers must produce an MSUK Competition licence. There is no charge for this, which is obtainable from the MSUK web site or by telephone. <https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/> Last minute volunteer navigators and passengers should be able to get a licence by ipad or smartphone on the morning at signing on.

4. The event is a round of the 2023 Inter-Register Championship.
5. The programme of the event will be:
 - Scrutineering and Signing on from 10.15 am. at the Shobdon Airfield, where refreshments will be available from 10.00. Any car not signed on by 11.00 may be penalised or refused a start.
 - Route cards will be issued from 11.00 am. Cars will leave in their own time.
 - Late lunch/afternoon teas will be available at around 15.30 back at the finish.
6. Competitors will cover around 65-75 miles depending on their chosen route. The OS Landranger map required for the event is OS148 (In the absence of motorway or HS2 construction any fairly recent edition should be useable). Apart from a Romer, ruler, pencils and eraser no instruments are required. Navigation will be by various common methods and should be readily achievable and unambiguous. Newcomers and beginner navigators may be provided with additional assistance if they ask nicely.
7. All entrants' cars must be road legal, i.e. 'taxed' for the road, and at signing on show their vehicle insurance. All drivers must hold a current Driving Licence for the car entered. There will be basic scrutineering for entries, Cars are strongly advised to carry a suitable fire extinguisher, fire sticks and/or fire blanket. Cars should have an additional throttle return spring.
8. The event will consist of three classes for Inter Register club members, Experts, Novices and Newcomers. An Expert crew will have a competed in more than three navigation rallies, a Novice crew in less than three. A Newcomer crew is one who has not previously entered any form of Navigation rally. Cars entered from clubs other than those in the Inter Register Trophy, whatever their competition history, will be in the Welcome class.

9. **The Entry List opens on the publication of these Regulations and closes on Saturday 2nd September.** If entry numbers allow this, entries *may* be accepted on the day (cash payment only), subject to notifying the event secretary on or before Tuesday 12th September.

10. Entry Fees will be £35.00 per vehicle.

All entries must be made on the official entry form accompanied by the appropriate fee. Cheques should be made payable to "Stephen Kay" and sent to the Secretary of the Meeting:

A refund, less £5 admin fee, will be given if entries are withdrawn and notification is given in writing or e-mail by the closing date. Cancellation after the closing date may incur loss of entry fee.

11. The maximum entry for this meeting, including reserves, is 30. The minimum is 8. Should this latter number not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt; however should the event be oversubscribed, priority will be given to Inter-Register Championship contenders.

12. The officials will be: Clerk of the Course: Colin Bromley, Scrutineer: Hugh Girvan Secretary of the Meeting: Stephen Kay

13. Any ties will be resolved in order of the number of adult crew, horsepower (RAC Rating) of the engine then the age of the car concerned.

14. Marking: There will be 20 locations to plot, and on visiting them a question must be answered, on the Score Card provided, as proof of visit. The locations will vary in score, ranging from 3 points to 15 points depending on the difficulty of plotting and /or getting there and/or finding the answer once there. You should aim to visit a MAXIMUM of 14 locations. If more than 14 answers are submitted only the 14 LOWEST scores will be counted. There will be a target finish time and penalty points will be awarded at the rate of one point per minute late after this time. Maximum lateness is 30 minutes. Arrival after this limit might result in disqualification. **To satisfy permit requirements and to assure a good relationship with the communities through which we will pass, the average speed for the event, travelling between clue points and stopping and observing each clue, point is 18 mph. The odometer reading will be recorded at signing on, and at the completion of the rally. Cars indicating a disregard for the average speed will be disqualified.**

15. Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with the MSA Regulations – Section C5

16. Awards: There will be:

- Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each class (subject to minimum of 10 in class); and a team prize. Special awards may be made at the discretion of the organisers.
- The Tom Pellow Award for the best crew, the Newcomers Award for the best newcomer
- Inter Register points will be awarded for individual places overall, and for team places, where a team comprises up to the highest scoring three cars of an Inter-Register Club.

17. The Hotspur café will be open in Shobdon's famous Nissen Hut before the start and when weary but happy crews return. It might assist Meg and her team if full teas are ordered before departure

18. Petrol is available from en route in Leintwardine or Leominster. Entrants with Shelsley specials or aero engined Brooklands cars may wish to fill up with AvGas at the airfield.
