In the case of the duotone finishes on the open models, the body, fairings and wheels will be in the lighter shade, the wings in the darker shade and the upholstery in the standard leather to tone with the external finish, except in the case of the Light Fawn and Old Ivory duotone finish when upholstery is in brown and with Ebony Black and White when any standard upholstery colour may be used. With the closed model the body, fairings and wheels are again the lighter shade, whilst wings, rooftoop are in darker shade ... "

- The first colour is the body colour, the second the upholstery and wheels. When a third colour is quoted it is that of the wheels only. Aluminium coloured wheels were not introduced until after production of the J-type ceased.
- So this description of colour is equivalent to Black/Red, a misprint for Black/Red/Black, perhaps?
- The file contains samples of flaking paint from both these colour pairs. They appear to be the same.
- An unfortunate choice!
