TRANSPORT

All goods are despatched by the most economical method. Should delivery via 'Red Star' (British Rail), Bus, Passenger train or Air Mail be required there will be an additional charge.

DELIVERY

New or secondhand bodies, complete cars or models partially dismantled or completely dismantled can be delivered by us anywhere in England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

SHIPPING

All arrangements for shipping goods overseas, such as packing, crating and dealing with all necessary paperwork can be carried out by us. Charges for collection from Chailey, Sussex, insurance, F.O.B., handling and all dock charges to be paid to Terry and Barry Bone.

We can offer practically any part for any of the OHC models from 1929 to 1935, except for some of the racing models.

Some of the more desirable items, such as instruments and Rotax headlights, are sold very quickly, and often take a while to replace as they are not easily obtainable these days.

MGs travel far and wide, and we try our utmost to help fellow enthusiasts to get their cars back on to the road, wherever they may be.

Please send us a list of the parts you require, together with a stamped addressed envelope (or International Reply Coupons) and we will do our best to help you. If you do not know the name of the parts, send us a drawing.

When ordering, please state the year, model and type of body of your car.

Should you be dissatisfied with the parts sent to you, or they are the wrong ones, we will guarantee to refund or replace. Parts should be returned within 10 days of date of despatch in U.K., or 112 days for Overseas customers, (or 21 days if sent by Air Mail).

All body parts listed above are made of steel, and to the original specification, size and shape. Front and rear wings include metal drip beads to underside. Front aprons include hinged flap over starting handle hole or louvres, depending on model.

Complete bodies can also be made, to original detail, and prices can be obtained on request.

SPECIFICATION OF TIMBER BODY FRAMES

Prices on previous sheet

Original bodies have been used as patterns, in order that the body frames may be accurate in every detail.

The complete timber frame is constructed of Utilee and Meranti, which are members of the Mahogany family.

The timbers are cut to shape from jigs which are matched from the original members, and are glued, screwed and rubbed down as they are assembled.


The assembled body includes the bulkhead, doors, hinges and all steel supports and ties within the timber structure.

All steel members are primed with red oxide and left ready to receive finishing coats.

The frame is completely assembled and left ready to receive the appropriate covering material.

The body frames are made to order and delivery is 8 to 12 weeks from confirmation of order together with first payment. A deposit of 50% of the total cost is required before work will commence. The remainder can be paid on completion, or by monthly or weekly instalments by Banker's Order to:-
